

Seniors who are eligible for this program must have an income less than \$30,350 per year.


For FY 2016-17, the average cost spent per client was \$1,083.

Medicare doesn't pay for dental unless supplemental plans are purchased.

Over 1,000 seniors are currently on a wait list for Senior Dental Program Services.

Most Health First Colorado members no longer receive dental benefits at the age of 65.
